The Russian fauna of the family Attelabidae requires the further studying. Twenty nine species have been recorded for the fauna of Russia [1]. In materials collected by V.Yu. Savitsky (Moscow) one species new for Russian fauna is found. This species were known from Japan [2]. Specimens are kept in the VSM – V. Savitsky collection (Russia, Moscow), and SZMN – Siberian Zoological Museum, Institute of Animal Systematics and Ecology (Russia, Novosibirsk).
